Prayer Points

Continue to pray for full recovery for those among us who have been suffering with ill-health recently, or who continue to suffer, including Emma Billington, Joyce Bungay, and Margaret Carey.

Pray for God's blessing on Charmaine's ministry through the week, and as she prepares for next week's service. And let's pray for us as a church as we start a new Sunday series looking at how Jesus 'wined and dined' with outcasts from society.

Pray for Baptist Missionary Society workers in Guinea, where the training of Guinean pastors and national mission workers is a priority. Pray for Simon Wood who has the responsibility of coordinating the training, and for the Guinean missionaries, with their families, who suffer abuse and even persecution when they move into a town to plant a church.

Let's continue to pray for Zimbabwe, where crumbling infrastructure and health services have resulted in cholera killing over 2,000 people so far, with more than 40,000 cases recorded. In addition, more than 5 million people, out of a population of 13 million, depend on food aid to stay alive. Pray for Christian aid organisations (like TearFund) working with local churches seeking to bring hope to Zimbabweans.
