On or about 15 September, David and Margie Whitehorn are driving to Mulhouse in Eastern France to spend 10 weeks at the WEC HQ there. They would value prayer as they immerse themselves in the French language and culture, and that they will be a blessing to the folk at the HQ. They return to the UK early December to prepare for their first visit to Africa as co-regional directors in early January 2012. While they will be based in the UK, at least initially, they plan to make prolonged visits to the different WEC teams in Africa, starting with Senegal in January. They ask for prayer as they prepare for this new role, and as they build up relationships with WEC team leaders in Africa.

The European Baptist Federation (EBF) is made up of more than 800,000 Baptists, in around 13,000 churches, in 51 Unions stretching from Portugal to the far reaches of Russia.
