An Easter Prayer: Forgive us, living Lord, that sometimes we are tempted to lose our nerve, to imagine that there is no new life, that death really does kill all hope. We pray that this Easter we may renew our hope, strengthen our nerve and rediscover hope rising again. We pray in the name of the risen Lord, our Lord Jesus Christ. Amen.

Pray for the work of JOPPA, which is the Baptist interfaith network, engaging in dialogue with other faiths, advising churches in their relationships with the religious communities they are living alongside, and producing materials on issues such as effective Christian witness in a multi-faith society.

Partners of Tearfund report that farmers in many regions of Pakistan are suffering because of a mixture of floods and droughts. Also, waterborne diseases, such as diarrhoea, regularly affect villagers who then lose out on making a living, and so the cycle of poverty continues. Let's ask that God will help Tearfund workers in their bid to make clean water and sanitation a daily reality for thousands in Pakistan over the next three years. Pray too for the stability of the country, an end to militancy, for wise leadership, and for Pakistan's relationship with the international community.
