The country remains one of the poorest, where most of the population work the land to survive. Give thanks for the work of Cambodian Hope Organisation (CHO), which is involved in business training and micro-loan schemes, helping people out of poverty and providing spiritual support. Pray for the CHO and the growth of its churches and cell groups, and its work with young people. Pray that the Cambodian government will continue to show signs of supporting CHO with its offer of cooperative strategies.
