

Prayer Points and Information

On this day of Pentecost, let's praise God for the presence and power of his Spirit in our lives – as individual followers of Jesus and in his body, the church. Let's pray that we will continually 'keep in step with the Spirit' (Galatians 5:25).

Pray for God's blessing on the Girls Brigade, for Ruth Rego and the other leaders, and for those who attend week by week.

Pray for a powerful sense of God's presence to all who, for different reasons, need to be reassured and strengthened by his love.

The Baptist Missionary Society encourages us to pray this week for Albania. While there have been signs of some economic progress, the country remains one of the poorest in Europe with unemployment very high. Albania made an application for membership of the European Union in 2009 but, before it can be considered, more needs to be done to stamp out organised crime and corruption and to develop media freedom and minority rights. Pray for: (1) ministry at Light of the World Baptist Church, Shkozë, Tirana; (2) the medical outreach project based at the church in Shkozë; (3) Beni Pango, General Secretary of the Albanian Baptist Union and pastor of Way of Hope Baptist Church, Tirana; (4) the Baptist church in Vlora, led by Graham Sansom and Ylli Beqiraj; (5) ongoing training of leaders for church life and pastoral oversight, which remains a priority for the young Albanian church; (6) BMS teachers at GDQ School in Tirana.
