On Remembrance Sunday, it is appropriate – without delighting in the horror of war – to be thankful for those who have given their lives on our behalf. As we do so, let's commit to the Lord our ongoing concerns about the many parts of the world today where fighting, violence and bloodshed are an everyday occurrence.

The Armed Forces' Christian Union note that being deployed in military conflict can focus the mind on the fragility of life and on eternal matters. A number of members of the Armed Forces have recently given their lives to Christ; some have been baptised and have had the opportunity to give their testimonies in front of their friends. They ask for prayer for all those deployed that they will be challenged to consider the gospel and give their lives to Christ. Pray for those who have been baptised that they might walk out in faith in intense conditions and witness to those around them. Pray that they will continue to walk in their faith when they return home.

Pray ahead of the church members' meeting next Sunday, that God will continue to give us wisdom as a church, and let's thank him for the promise that he will guide us and be with us in all things.

Chronic malnutrition is on the rise in Zimbabwe. Long periods of drought have led to severe crop shortages in a country where almost two million people live with hunger after critically poor harvests in recent years. Pray for those helping in relief efforts, and for all the people affected by the drought in Zimbabwe.
