Prayer Points

Let's use the words of Paul in Colossians 1:9-14 to pray for ourselves as a church – for knowledge of God's will, for wisdom and understanding, for living a life worthy of the Lord and pleasing him in every way, for bearing fruit in every good work, for growing in the knowledge of God, for being strengthened with his power so that we may have great endurance and patience, and giving thanks to the Father.

As the Sunday Club starts again, let's pray for the work that takes place with children, that God would bless them and strengthen those who teach them, especially Pat Davidson and Margaret Reynolds who shoulder most of the ministry.

China is the world's fastest growing economy; it spreads out across almost 4 million square miles and is home to 1.3 billion people. It's also a country where the Baptist Missionary Society has sent 400 workers over a 90-year period. This month, starting on 14 September, a delegation is making a two-week visit to China to celebrate past work and to discern how the BMS might be able to re-start involvement there. They ask that supporters will uphold this visit in prayer – especially that it might open doors to future work and that people would come forward to serve in China.
