Prayer Points

Saturday 21 November is the Baptist Family Day of Prayer. Kingsley Appageyi, the President of the Baptist Union of Great Britain, asks us to pray: (1) That churches will come together on the day of the event to raise an urgent prayer of repentance, and that there will be a divine intervention for our nation. (2) That we will return to the Word of God. (3) That the hearts and minds of our young people might be open to the living presence of God's Spirit. (4) That a fresh sense of love and unity will begin to flow in our churches.

Pray that the lessons we have learned from Jonah on 'Grace and Rebellion' will continue to take root in our hearts.

With a population of 15 million, Niger (in West Africa) is a mainly Muslim country, although there is a Christian minority. It was rated nearly bottom of the most recent UN Human Development Index, coming 174th out of 179 nations ranked by quality of life. At the moment, pressure is growing on the president of Niger amid concerns over the unconstitutional use of power. Let's pray for political stability in Niger and for an end to the current crisis. Pray too for good government which helps the people of Niger living in poverty improve their status. Pray for Tearfund and other aid organisations as they bring hope to poor communities.
