A message from Paul Martin (London Baptist Association):  
'Following the outcome of the interviews for the Regional Minister post in December, when it was decided not to nominate any of the candidates for the position, the directors of the LBA have taken the decision not to rush back into the appointment process. January has been set aside for waiting on God. We are seeking to ensure that we hear what God may have been saying to us through the disappointment of December. We are inviting the churches of the Association to join with us through this time in seeking God's guidance for our life together.' Let's pray for Paul and others in the LBA office as they seek wisdom from God for the future.

Pray for next Sunday, for an enjoyable time of fellowship over lunch together, and for God to bless us with his presence and insight in discussion and decision-making at the church members' meeting.

Last Wednesday marked the first anniversary of the Haiti earthquake which left more than 250,000 dead and 1.5 million others homeless. Let's give thanks for the progress being made in helping recovery and for the giving that has enabled relief organisations to respond. Pray for the bereaved for whom the anniversary will bring emotional pain as they remember the loss of loved ones, and ask that God will bring them comfort. Pray for the work of aid groups, the Haitian government and the international community, that obstacles to quicker recovery will be overcome.
