

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for churches across the country this week as Christians celebrate Easter. Pray for churches that are doing special Easter events for children and families, for good weather and attendance. Pray that the resurrection hope of Easter will impact communities – that they will come to understand how Christ can bring them hope.

Lets’s pray for strength and restoration for those who are currently wrestling in one way or another with ill-health.

Pray that God will speak through his word as you read it this week.

Pray for those involved in organisations like ‘Christian Concern for Our Nation’, who seek to represent a distinctively Christian voice in different areas of society, and who frequently face hostility and ridicule as they do so.

Around 30 evangelical churches have been planted in Kosovo since 1999 among the majority ethnic-Albanians but there are five other ethnic groups represented in Kosovo and they are frequently marginalised and discriminated against. Pray for those who are ministering to Kosovars on the margins. Pray for BMS workers Jas and Layla and supported partner workers Dmitri and Daria, ministering to one of the marginalised minority ethnic groups in Kosovo. Pray too for Zeljko Mraz, General Secretary of the Baptist Union of Croatia, leading Baptists and frequently representing Evangelicals in general to the government and to the media.
