Let's use those reports as a prompt for further prayer – that we will continue to move forward as a church, confident in God's blessing of us, and seeking to use the gifts he has given us.

Pray that God will sustain and bless the work of Mission Aviation Fellowship in different parts of the world. Pray for John and Cher Cadd, serving with MAF in East Congo.

It is estimated that 800,000 people have fled their homes due to fighting taking place in Pakistan. This is on top of another 500,000 displaced by earlier conflict. The UN has expressed concerns for civilian suffering to the Pakistani president Asif Zardari, and UN agencies are looking to increase the supply of basic aid, such as food and shelter. Let's pray for the 1.3 million people who have been displaced and that aid gets through to help them. Pray for Tearfund and other relief organisations as they plan how to respond.
