The Ugandan rebel group, the Lord's Resistance Army, has been involved in a long running civil conflict but since being driven from Uganda. Its attacks have moved over the border into the Democratic Republic of Congo and neighbouring Sudan. Pray that the armies pursuing the LRA will show wisdom and restraint as many of the LRA 'fighters' were themselves abducted and forced to join, and pray for a peaceful and negotiated settlement of the conflict between the LRA and the government of Uganda.
