Following on from today's sermon, let's pray for a deepening of our relationship with people in the local community.

Pray for the family day next Saturday – that the final preparations will go smoothly, and that the day itself will be fun and will increase the church's profile in the neighbourhood in a positive way as well as our contact with people in the local community.

Pray for the team who are meeting regularly to prepare for the holiday club, due to be held during the first week of August. Let's ask that God will bless that week in a special and evident way with his presence and power.

Pray for those in the church family who are currently suffering with ill-health.

Six months after the Haiti earthquake, the scale of the rebuilding challenge remains massive. Pray for survivors who are still suffering, that they will come to terms with their losses and have the energy and motivation to begin their lives anew. Pray for wisdom for Haiti's government as it presides over the recovery effort. Pray for the church to bring light into the darkness of this post-disaster situation.
