Pray for our holiday club for children in the local area, taking place 3–7 August, with a special service on the 9th. Pray for those who will lead the activities and for the children themselves, that they will have a fun time coming into the church building, and will respond well to us and the message they hear.

David Shosanya, LBA's regional minister for mission, reminds us of some stories in the news recently which prompt us to pray: the death of six-year-old school girl Chloe Buckley and the Bedfordshire based GP Dr Michael Day from Swine Flu; the death of 15 soldiers in Afghanistan – three of them aged 18 – which has heightened interest in the war and the issue of whether the government has made adequate provision for British soldiers; similarly, a concern for the one million or so young people Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET) and the sentencing of 6 young men for the violent murder of Shakilus Townsend has brought the issue of young people back into sharp focus. Let's pray that the perpetrators, victims, family and friends affected by each of these stories will find comfort, purpose, forgiveness and peace in Christ and through each other.
