

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for Martin and Heike Dolan in their ministry in Cyprus, that God will continue to bless and sustain them. Pray also that God will use them to bring others to Jesus and that he will give them wisdom to teach and nurture disciples who will themselves become 'missionaries' for Jesus in their everyday contexts.

Pray for our ongoing presence and witness in the local area – not just as individuals and as families where we live, but as a church – that God will help us make a difference to the lives of people on our own doorstep.

Think about and pray for those in our congregation who are out in the 'workplace' during the week; in addition to doing a good job, ask that God will give grace so that they may bring the light and hope of Christ wherever they find themselves.

Give thanks for those who work in the offices of the London Baptist Association in their support of the Baptist churches in our region. Pray for ongoing wisdom and insight in their daily tasks.

Pray for the current situation in Syria: (1) for unity among believers, both within Syria and with other Arab nations; (2) for the strength, health, emotional and spiritual well-being of missionaries and their families; (3) that those in high ranking offices will be reached with the gospel; (4) that those who are believers within the government will have favour as well as opportunities to speak of Christ.
