Prayer Points

Pray for our holiday club for children in the local area, taking place 3–7 August, with a special service on the 9th. Pray for those who will lead the activities and for the children themselves, that they will have a fun time coming into the church, and will respond well to us and the message they hear.

Like us, Shirley Baptist Church in Southampton receives a grant from home mission, without which the church could not run. Praise God, with them, for thriving youth work amongst children under 14, and pray for guidance and personnel to put something in place for older young people. Pray too for the church's large social action programme, which includes a Child Contact Centre for separated couples, where the non-resident parent meets with his/her children in a safe environment, a Lunch Club, a large Senior Citizens' club and a Toddler Group. A weekly Advice Centre provides free advice from solicitors, councillors and NHS health trainers. They ask us to pray that all this work will be done in the name of Christ and new ways will be found of linking it into church life.

The Evangelical Baptist Church of Angola is holding leadership elections. Pray for the leaders and delegates as they meet for the general assembly, that God will guide them, and pray for the leadership team as they face the challenges ahead.
