

# Prayer Points and Information

Continue to pray for those who are unwell or undergoing ongoing medical treatment, including Margaret Carey and Tom Kelly.

Pray for Charmaine and members of the youth group as they prepare to lead next week's worship service. Ask God to continue to speak to them, that they may truly know Christ as their Saviour and Lord, and would be aware of his presence with them in their lives.

Pray for various meetings taking place this week, including the Wednesday Fellowship and the Focus for Men group. Let's ask that God will bless these times when we gather together.

Tearfund asks us to pray for the hundreds of orphaned children who roam the streets of Uganda's capital, Kampala. Most have drifted in from rural areas blighted by decades of civil war. Some are former child soldiers and the rest come from nearby slum areas following family breakdown – through HIV/AIDS, poverty and domestic violence. *Amahoro* (an East African word for peace) provides centres of refuge to children: loving communities that offer a sense of home, and where children can learn life skills and values from peer mentors and church volunteers. Pray for all those involved in *Amahoro*: for God's guidance in reaching and nurturing children who have suffered damage in their formative years, for the mentors and staff who care for the children – that they will be strengthened. Pray that God will keep providing for the project's needs as it grows and reaches out to the huge numbers of children in Kampala.
