Prayer Points

Pray for strength and healing for those among us who continue to wrestle with ill-health.

Our own church depends financially on a substantial grant from the Baptist Union Home Mission Fund every year. Home Mission is the Baptist national 'purse' and is the way that the Baptist family supports one another. Pray for the Home Mission appeal, that it will be reached, despite the difficult financial climate. Pray for wisdom for Grants Manager, Rachel Tole, and the Grants Committee as they make decisions on which projects and church situations can be supported.

Tens of thousands of people have been affected by severe flooding in the West African state of Burkina Faso. Tearfund has five local church-based partners there, who are assessing the damage and looking to meet people's physical and spiritual needs. They ask us to give thanks that local churches have been able to respond quickly to offer support, and to pray with them that God will comfort those affected by the floods as they rebuild properties and livelihoods. They also ask for prayer for their spiritual and emotional wellbeing, that the Lord will bring healing to those left traumatised, and that diseases such as cholera and typhoid do not spread because of the floods.
