The government of Tunisia is keen to develop relationships with Europe and the USA. The result of this is not only better trade and better opportunities for some, but also a growing exposure to western 'values', leading to an increase in drug and alcohol abuse and teenage pregnancies. Pray for Baptist Missionary Society workers who are working alongside partners in Tunisia to address these issues and seeking to help those in need. Pray also for local churches as they deal with issues of leadership and discipleship in an Islamic context where the authorities are hostile towards Christians.
