Think about just one aspect of the life and ministry of the church – the Sunday ministry, our work with children, the 60+ group, our pastoral commitment to each other, the ongoing cleaning of the building – and ask that the Lord will bless it and those involved in it.

Continue to pray for peace in Tunisia which has suffered a month of turbulence, leading to a new government being formed. Clashes between protesters and the police over high unemployment and food prices escalated and led to the country's president fleeing into exile. This week a new administration took over, promising political reforms and greater freedoms. Let's pray for stability and an end to bloodshed in Tunisia, and pray for the new government as it seeks to deliver the reforms it has promised.

Pray for God's protection for his people in Ivory Coast and Liberia as they respond to the needs of those who have fled the violence.
