Prayer Points

Pray for grace and strength for those in our church and wider circles who are suffering with seasonal colds, sore throats, chest infections and other ailments.

Pray for school-age children in the church and for their parents during this week of half term, that the rhythm of pause and rest will be a positive one for families.

Six Baptist Missionary Society Action Teams (each made up of 25 young people) are just starting six-month mission placements in Santos (Brazil), São Paulo (Brazil), Delhi (India), Kolkata (India), Sicily and Uganda. They ask for prayer for positive friendships within the teams, safety and good health, and opportunities to share Jesus with people they meet.

Kumar Rajagopalan, the Regional Minister for Racial Justice in the London Baptist Association, asks us to pray following the controversial appearance of Nick Griffin, the leader of the British National Party, on BBC's Question Time. He asks us to pray for Nick Griffin himself, that God will speak into his life, and that those who watched the programme will be discerning in any response. He also encourages us to ask the Lord to forgive us for our failure to hear and address the needs of the white working class, which the BNP now seem to be exploiting.
