Pray that the Word of God taught every Sunday as part of our morning worship would take deep root and make a real difference in our lives as individual disciples of Christ and as a body of his people.

Continue to pray for those who are suffering in various ways, physically and emotionally, and for strength for those who shoulder the burden of caring for them.

Along with other organisations, the Baptist Missionary Society is involved in a scheme which currently enables 60 indigenous church leaders across Eastern Europe to serve among their own peoples. Pray for Daniel Trusiewicz from Poland, co-ordinating the project. Pray too for Igor and Anita Urosevits, church planting in Ruma, Serbia; for Daniel Gherman and his wife, in Uzusu, Romania; for Teodor and Silvia Groza, in Viseu de Sus, Romania; and for Stepan Bondar and his wife, in Tula, Russia.

Let's continue to pray for the people of Japan in the aftermath of the recent earthquake and tsunami, as well as the ongoing concerns over the damage at the Fukushima nuclear power station. In addition to the tens of thousands who have died, hundreds of thousands of people are also homeless. Pray for speedy relief efforts to help those who have been affected, needing shelter, food, water and medical help. Pray that those who belong to Christ will be a source of light and strength to those who grieve and are in need.
