

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for those who have been suffering with ill-health.

Let's pray for God's blessing on John Howard as he is inducted and affirmed in his chaplaincy role on Monday evening this week. Ask that God will continue to give him wisdom and insight in his conversations with workers and travellers at Heathrow Airport.

Pray for Gordon and Annette Miller and their family. Gordon has recently made the decision to continue at the seminary full-time until the end of 2013 when he reaches retirement age. Pray that God will confirm this decision, and will continue to lead him towards the right opportunities for ongoing ministry after his formal retirement.

Thursday 1 December is World AIDS Day. Since the beginning of the epidemic, nearly 30 million people have died from AIDS-related causes. Pray for adults and children who have been bereaved, for those who are seriously ill and impoverished, and for every initiative seeking to provide treatment, support and training.

Pray for the people of the Democratic Republic of Congo as presidential elections take place on Monday 28 November. Against a backdrop of reported violence and intimidation, the Congolese people will have to decide who will lead their mineral-rich country for the next five years. The Baptist Missionary Society asks us to pray for peace in Congo, for elections to be free and fair, for wisdom for voters, and for competent leaders to be elected.
