Pray for Christian leaders in Chad, many of whom form the 'Entente', which seeks to represent Christian interests before the Islamic government. Pray for Rebecca North, a BMS long-term worker who, in addition to using her nursing skills, will be learning French when she arrives in N'Djamena in September. Pray for her adjustment to life in Chad. BMS doctors Mark and Andrea Hotchkin. Pray for Mark's wisdom and skill as he leads the medical team at Guinebor 2.
