Remember farm workers and slum dwellers, and pray that governments and other agencies will find the will and ability to solve these problems. Pray that more people in the poorest countries will have access to good, affordable or free medical care. Give thanks for those engaged in building hospitals, training staff, providing finances and developing mobile units that can reach the remotest areas.

Two successive tropical storms in the last fortnight have caused severe damage to homes and infrastructure in Mozambique, one of the world's poorest nations. Pray for: (1) the thousands of families in the country recovering from the storm; (2) BMS workers, Christine and Geoff Holder, as they seek how best to help in the situation, and that they would remain safe and healthy in difficult conditions; (3) those bringing aid, and that the damaged communications and infrastructure would not hamper their efforts too much; (4) wisdom for BMS as they assess how best to use relief money.
