Let's pray for the wider region of North Africa: for wise rulers in Egypt who will bring stability to the country; for a peaceful transition in Tunisia to a state that is accountable to its citizens; for protection of vulnerable groups of people; for those who have been victims of violence in Libya; for those grieving loved ones, detained unlawfully and needing urgent medical help.

Twenty years after declaring its independence from the Soviet Union, Belarus still seems uncertain about its future. Despite many people's hopes for democratic reform, its Soviet-style president is set on keeping firm political and economic control. Away from the political frontline, however, many younger Christians are eager for their faith to inspire the country's future. The Bible Society asks us to pray for Christian students as they share their faith with other Belarusian students, and for the impact of materials and especially the new Belarusian Bible on the country's younger generation.
