Read and reflect on Colossians 1:1-20 in preparation for next week's service, and ask that the Lord will speak to us as a church as we spend the next few weeks looking at Colossians.

Pray for Afghanistan while votes continue to be counted after the recent election. The fighting in the Helmand province, and the deaths of British soldiers in particular, has been making the news in the UK – but behind these headlines are people living in poverty, seeking peace and justice, and in need of Christ. Pray that God will bless them with a government dedicated to the development of the country and the removal of corrupt and criminal elements, and pray for the safety of those who are trying to work for the betterment of the Afghan people.
