Members and friends of NPBC will want to know the sad news that Galina Dawson died on Friday 21 January 2011 at her son's house in Sillamae, Estonia. Her breast cancer had spread and she had tumors on her lungs which caused breathing difficulties due to persistent fluid. Her daughter-in-law was with her at the time. Her funeral took place on Tuesday 25 January at the Orthodox Church in Sillamae, followed by a local burial. Vasili, her son, told Ray that 'she passed away in the best possible manner, meaning that she was here with us, which is what she really wanted'. Let's pray for Galina's family at this time, as well as for Ray and Peter – for peace and comfort from God, and his sustaining strength as they work through their grief.

Continue to pray for those amongst us who are currently suffering with ill-health, asking God to sustain them and renew them.
