Pray for those who suffer from the effects of homelessness and exclusion, and for those who seek to support them through housing, training and employment.

Pray for wisdom for all who work with Christian Concern, an organisation which seeks to introduce a Christian voice into law, media and government, encouraging Christians to stand up and speak out on issues that matter. Pray as they defend Christians who are suffering severe consequences for standing up for their beliefs.

Nepal's divided government is struggling to write the country's first constitution. Strikes and disruption continue to make everyday life difficult. Pray that agreement in the government will be reached through dialogue and relationship building, and that laws limiting legitimate religious activity won't be passed. Pray for existing Christian ministries who are offering help to needy people in rural Nepal, and that BMS workers who are new to the country will settle in and learn the language and culture quickly and well.
