

Prayer Points and Information

Continue to pray for peace and strength for our children and young people as they return to school, and pray for God's blessing on the various church activities as they resume after the summer break.

Give thanks for Gordon and Annette Miller, and pray that God will bless the family as they celebrate Amy's graduation from UCL.

Pray for strength and restoration to health for all those who are currently unwell or suffering in other ways, perhaps with anxiety or depression, or because they are under stress.

Twelve million people remain at risk across the region of East Africa, and 29,000 under-5s have already died as a result of food and water shortages. The Famine Early Warning Systems Network has estimated that high levels of food insecurity will turn into famine in most areas of southern Somalia within four to six weeks. Tearfund partners, who are currently helping 93,000 people across the region, ask for our prayers, or encourage us to use this prayer: Father God we pray that your peace, which restores and heals, will be evident in the midst of the turmoil in East Africa, and will be outworked through your church. May the land once again produce food for the people. May the hungry and displaced be comforted in every sense. May the conflict and insecurity come to an end in Somalia. May the price of food and fuel stabilise to relieve pressure on poor families. May the compassion of your people be expressed here in the UK and in East Africa. Amen.
