Prayer Points

Pray for refreshment for parents and children during this period of holiday from school.

Pray for local churches as we celebrate Easter this week. Pray for all churches across the land that are dramatising the events of Holy Week, that are bringing to life Palm Sunday with palm leaves and donkeys, carrying a cross through the streets of where they live on Good Friday, and meeting early on Easter Sunday to celebrate the risen Lord. Pray for churches that are doing special Easter events for children and families, that the resurrection hope of Easter will make a genuine impact on communities in this country.

Civil war in Sri Lanka is taking a heavy toll on children, not only through death but also through a lack of food, water and medicines. In the UK on 11 April, Tamil churches will fast and pray for peace in Sri Lanka. They ask us to join in offering prayers to God for peace, that the Sri Lankan government and Tamil Tigers will have higher regard for the safety of the civilian population; to pray for the wounded and traumatised, particularly children, that God will meet their needs; to pray for the safety of aid organisations trying to help non-combatants and for improved access to those in need.
