

Prayer Points and Information

Continue to pray for peace and comfort for Joan Varney and the wider family after the death of her sister following a long illness.

Pray that God will continue to strengthen our relationships with each other in the wider family of the church, that we will learn to love one another more, care for one another with sincerity of heart, and seek to serve one another.

Let's pray for the ongoing situation in Libya: for God to show his mercy, to bring stability to the region, and to give wisdom to world leaders to know how to react in such a volatile situation.

As Ivory Coast's political crisis rumbles on, hundreds of people continue to flee the country on a daily basis. Many end up in neighbouring Liberia, drawn by ethnic ties and a local population willing to host them. But for host communities in Liberia, compassion is bringing tough conditions. Pray for Tearfund partner EQUIP, based in Liberia, as they help refugees in operating health clinics, providing health education and awareness on gender-based violence. Thank God for the generosity of Liberian hosts and pray that the stalemate caused by the disputed November elections would be resolved so Ivorians can resume normal life. Ask God to strengthen host communities as they strive to meet refugees' everyday needs. Pray too for greater international recognition of the suffering caused by the ongoing standoff between Ivory Coast's incumbent president and opposition leader.
