

Prayer Points and Information

Pray for the church groups and organisations which take a break from their regular meeting over the summer weeks. Ask that God will bless the opportunity to pause and rest from the routine, and that they will resume with renewed energy and excitement.

Let's use the words of Paul in Ephesians 5:1-20 to pray for ourselves as a church – that we may live a life worthy of the Lord and pleasing him in every way, bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of Christ, and being filled with his Spirit.

Pray for the South West Baptist Association. They have placed a church planter in the market town of Newton Abbot in Devon and are currently looking to appoint a second church planter to work in Cornwall. They ask for prayer for these two projects.

Ecuadorian society is plagued by high levels of domestic violence and abuse. In this context, defending the cause of the fatherless, rescuing the weak and needy, fighting against injustice and working with the churches to help them show Christ's love in action, are key elements in BMS' mission commitment there. Pray for: (1) the exploration of fresh initiatives with churches and agencies in Guayaquil, which aim to bring new life and hope into situations of deprivation and exploitation; (2) the continued impact of the School of Mission, as it trains lay leaders in centres around Ecuador; (3) the continued growth of the PEPE pre-school mission programme now adopted by some 30 churches and headed up by Angelica Gutierrez.
