### Prayer Points

On Remembrance Sunday, it is appropriate – without glorying in the horror of war – to be thankful for those who have given their lives on our behalf. Let's commit to the Lord our ongoing concerns about the many parts of the world where fighting, violence and bloodshed are an everyday occurrence. Pray also for those who live each day with the after-effects of war – for the bereaved, the psychologically scarred, orphaned children, and the weak, whose suffering often continues with famine and scarce resources in the wake of conflict.

Let's pray for those in our church fellowship and among our family, friends and neighbours who continue to be affected by the current economic situation. Pray for peace and resilience, and that people who need to be in employment to support themselves and their family will find and be able to stay in suitable jobs.

The Baptist Missionary Society asks to pray for 34,000 refugees from Angola who crossed the border into Democratic Republic of Congo for shelter, but who have been forced to return to Angola. Pray that they would have good shelter, supplies, health, safety, support and eventually a home, and pray for the people and communities left in Congo – husbands, wives, children, businesses and services left without workers.
