## Prayer Points

On Remembrance Sunday, it is appropriate – without glorying in the horror of war – to be thankful for those who have given their lives on our behalf. As we do so, let's commit to the Lord our ongoing concerns about the many parts of the world where fighting, violence and bloodshed are an everyday occurrence. Pray also for those who live each day with the after-effects of war – for the bereaved, the psychologically scarred, orphaned children, and the weak, whose suffering often continues with famine and scarce resources in the wake of conflict.

Pray for President-Elect Barack Obama, for his wife and family, for his administration, and for the United States of America – not least because of the influence of its policies on the wider world. Ask that God will give him wisdom and strength to do his tasks, and that he will seek the advice of wise counsellors as he faces an array of challenges and choices in the weeks ahead.

Let's pray for those in our church fellowship and among our family, friends and neighbours who have been adversely affected by the current economic situation. Pray for peace and resilience, and that people who need to be in employment to support themselves and their family will find suitable jobs.

Give thanks that Christ's death brings about reconciliation.
