### Prayer Points

Pray for Olu Falowo as he prepares to minister God's Word to us next Sunday. Let's pray too for ourselves as individuals and collectively as a church, that we will hear God's voice in the pages of Scripture, learn from it, and be given grace to act on it.

Let's pray ahead of the Christmas season for God's blessing on church services and other Christian ventures in the local area.

The Baptist Missionary Society is urging Christians not to forget Congo, and to pray for a just peace, where Congo's rich resources benefit the Congolese people and not a handful of foreign companies or violent militias. Use the TearFund flyer enclosed with this week's news-sheet to be informed and to pray into the ongoing situation.

Wednesday is World Toilet Day! 2.5 billion people worldwide don't have a toilet, and that lack of a basic facility takes its toll on communities in developing countries, where every day 5,000 children under five die from diarrhoeal diseases caused by dirty water. Sanitation also provides dignity; inadequate access is a source of shame, physical discomfort and insecurity. Pray for greater resolve and action to tackle inadequate sanitation, and that governments – including the British government – will be galvanised into action.
