Unicef reports that Afghanistan has the fourth highest infant mortality and maternal death rate in the world. Superstition, folklore and the entrenched social systems of a country at war for the past 25 years have meant that most women are denied basic care. Pray for resilience and grace for Baptist Missionary Society workers and nurses who are seeking to offer support to women and children in tough situations.
